**REPORT OF THE CITIZENS' CONSULTATIVE FORUM FOR THE
YEAR 2020 BUDGET, HELD FROM 4TH TO 6TH SEPTEMBER, 2019
ACROSS THE THREE(3) SENATORIAL DISTRICTS IN THE STATE
OF OSUN**

1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 In its passionate efforts to make Budget process robust, inclusive, participatory and sustainable, the Ministry of Economic Planning and Budget in collaboration with the State Fiscal Transparency, Accountability and Sustainability Programme (SFTAS) rolled out a 3-day interactive session with stakeholders on socio-economic development of the State. The need to engage citizens became imperative so as to allow them have inputs in the budgetary processes of the State and monitor its implementation with belief that government exists for the people and the limited resources available should be judiciously allocated to meet yearnings and aspirations of the citizens.

1.2 The meeting created an avenue to showcase efforts of the State Government to enhance quality of life of its citizens through planning and designing people oriented policies and programmes, and appropriate budgeting that will have impacts on lives of the people. It also gave a platform to engage the citizens of the State and harvest information on critical areas of needs that can be included in the year 2020 Budget.

3.0 OPENING

3.1 The consultative meeting commenced with an opening prayer at 10:00am. This was followed by recitation of the Osun and the National Anthems.

3.2 Welcome Remarks

3.2.1 The Hon. Commissioner, Ministry of Economic Planning and Budget (MEP&B), Prof. Olalekan Yinusa welcomed the participants to the Forum. He appreciated the Governor for his visionary style of governance. He described the Citizens Consultative Forum as the most effective method that allows citizens to have inputs in policy-making process of the government. He noted that public participation is one way of decreasing tension and conflict over public decisions. He spoke further that in seeking public inputs early in the budget process, citizens become knowledgeable about fiscal situation, which in turn allows them to make informed decisions. He therefore explained that the reasons for calling the meetings were to allow citizen to:

- have inputs in year 2020 Budget;
- make 2020 Budget an all inclusive one; and
- act as a monitoring stakeholders so that government can have adequate feedback on its programmes and projects being executed.

3.2.2 The Hon. Commissioner emphasized that the State Government is highly interested in the development of Agriculture, Mining, Culture and Tourism Sectors in the State. He disclosed that Government will provide necessary training and give credit facility to farmers when need arises. He however implored farmers to always be truthful and pay up Agric Loans given to them by Government so that they will not deny other farmers access to the same benefit they have enjoyed.

3.2.3 He appreciated the participants especially the Kabiyesis, the Religious and Opinion Leaders, Iyalojas and Babalojas, Members of Osun State Farmers' Association, Members of the State NURTW, CSOs, NGOs, Media Group and representatives of MDAs that attended the forum with the promise that they would inform Mr. Governor of the priority needs being requested by the people. He therefore charged all stakeholders to support the government to achieve its goals by paying their taxes and other levies regularly, adding that everyone has roles to play in securing a brighter and sustainable future for the State.

3.3 Mr. Aderemi Kolajo, Special Adviser to the Governor thanked the participants for attending the Forum. He explained that the cardinal objective of the meeting is to ensure that citizens are actively involved in the budget process of the State so that they can properly monitor its implementation. The Special Adviser noted that successful citizens' participation exercise is an integral part of planning process. He appreciated the participants for their time and unflinching supports for betterment of the State. He therefore charged them to contribute meaningfully as their inputs would help the State Government to work on priorities that best suited their needs.

3.4 The Coordinating Director, Ministry of Economic Planning and Budget, Mr. Kunle Akinola welcomed the participants to the forum and appreciated them for their sacrifice and commitment to make the State better. He informed them that Citizens' Consultative Forum is an avenue to carried people along in the budget process. He stressed that the engagement of the citizens in policy formulation will help the State to identify the priority programmes and projects that are critical to the citizens. He therefore wished the participants happy and fruitful deliberations.

3.5 The State's SFTAS Focal Officer, Mrs. Yetunde Esan informed the participants that the essence of the Citizens' Consultative Forum is to ensure that there is inclusiveness, bottom up and top down approach, Openness and Citizens' Engagement in the Budget Process as stipulated in the Disbursement Link Indicator 2 (DLI2) of the SFTAS Programme. She added that although the State of Osun in collaboration with the World Bank/DFID had earlier carried out Needs Assessment across Thirty(30) plus One(1) LGAs early in the year but there is still need to engage citizens on their areas priority needs as a result of environmental dynamism. She noted that periodic consultations of citizens in public decision making will bring about transparency, accountability and public trust in Government. She therefore enjoined the participants to maximize the opportunity by making relevant contributions that will have positive impacts on the people they represent.

3.6 Hon. Kujembola, the Chairman of Atakumosa West Local Government, who spoke on behalf of other Local Government Chairmen, noted that long before now, there was no formal mechanism in the State to invite citizens to participate in the budgeting process until recent time. He then described the Citizens' Consultative Forum as a right step in a right direction because it provides an avenue for people at the grassroots to be represented and participated in the budget making process. He charged the participants to contribute genuinely and reasonably so that their needs can be could captured in the year 2020 Budget.


