# MINUTES OF THE CITIZENS' CONSULTATIVE FORUM ON THE YEAR 2021 PROPOSED BUDGET, HELD FROM 20<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER - 2<sup>ND</sup> NOVEMBER 2020 ACROSS THE SENATORIAL DISTRICTS IN THE STATE OF OSUN

#### 1.0 PREAMBLE

- 1.1 The Ministry of Economic Planning and Budget rolled out a 3-day interactive programme with the relevant stakeholders in the State. This is in its continual efforts to make the State Budget process robust, inclusive, participatory, and transparent. The meeting was an avenue for the citizens to articulate their minds and have inputs in the year 2021 budget before being taken to the State House of Assembly for consideration and approval.
- 1.2 The Participants selected across the Local Governments were representatives of:

## 2.0 WELCOME REMARKS

- On behalf of Mr. Governor, State of Osun, the Hon. Commissioner, Ministry of Economic Planning and Budget, Prof. Olalekan Yinusa welcomed the participants to the meeting. While addressing participants across the three (3) Senatorial Districts, the Commissioner Hon. explained that Citizens' Consultative Engagement Forum has become a yearly event in the State because it is the only way to give credence to transparency and accountability. He stated that Governor Adeboyega Oyetola is highly interested in running an inclusive, and open, participatory Government that give utmost priority to citizens of the State.
- 2.2 The Hon. Commissioner added that the present administration is committed to complete all the ongoing projects in the State so as to avoid wastage of economic resources and improve standard of living of the populace. He explained that in a bid to ensure the State policies and programmes are driven by citizens, Governor Oyetola immediately embarked on **Thank You Tour** to the Nine (9) Federal Constituencies of the State after his administration was inaugurated to harvest information on critical area of needs of the people. This was further confirmed by the United Kingdom Department for International Development (UKDFID) which partner with the State Government to carry out **Citizens' Needs Assessments** across Thirty (30) Local Governments plus One (1) Area Office in the State. He

informed that all the requests made by citizens have been documented and mainstreamed into the Medium-Term Sector Strategy (MTSS) of the State. He thereafter disclosed that the reasons for calling the meetings were to:

- engage citizens of the State and harvest information on critical areas of needs that can be included in the year 2021 Budget;
- allow citizens to have inputs in the budget process of the State and monitor its implementation
- allow citizens to give feedback on the level of implementation of the year 2020 Budget.

2.3 The Hon. Commissioner further explained that the upsurge of Covid-19 pandemic which grounded the World Economy for months has led to fall in revenue generation of the State. This necessitated the State Government to review its originally approved year 2020 budget to be" COVID-19 responsive" so as to mitigate its effects on the citizenry. The Hon. Commissioner maintained that despite the economic hardship occasioned by the Pandemic, the State Government has been able to deliver on her promises, most especially in areas of Health, Education, Staff Welfare, Human Capital Development, Agriculture and Infrastructural Development. Also, Government has been able to increase its commitment to development of Small and Medium Scale Enterprises in the State. He stressed that the massive rehabilitation of Primary Health Care Centres across 332 political wards in the State and the passage of the Osun Health Insurance Scheme into Law were proofs that the present administration really care about its people. In addition, the recent removal of embargoes on annual salary increments, promotion, conversion, and implementation of minimum wage


were indications that the present administration sees workers' welfare as priority.

2.4 The Hon. Commissioner noted that the world economy is still very much fragile, stressing that the war against COVID-19 pandemic has not yet finally won. He, therefore, implored people to always observed Covid-19 lay down protocols in every situation. He enjoined the participants to be direct and specific so that their requests could be well captured. He charged people to always monitor projects and programmes embarked upon by the State Government and draw attention to areas where its interventions are urgently needed. He therefore appreciated the participants and wished them fruitful deliberations.

## 3.0 PRESENTATION OF YEAR 2021 PROPOSED BUDGET

3.1 The Director of Economic Planning, Mrs. Yetunde Esan took the participants through the nitty-gritty of the proposed budget. She explained that the year 2021 proposed budget was crafted based on the State of Osun Development Plan (2021-2023), Medium Term Sector Strategy (2021-2023), Mr. Governor's Manifesto, the Thank You Tour Report and Citizens Needs Assessments carried out in the thirty (30) Local Governments plus one (1) Area Office of the State. She spoke further that the State Government considered it very necessary to engage people of the three Senatorial Districts in order to harvest meaningful contributions and incorporate them into the year 2021 Draft Budget.

3.2 In her presentation, she informed the participants that a sum of N109.5billion has been proposed for the year 2021 with Capital Expenditure of N59.2billion and Recurrent Expenditure of




N50.6billion. She pointed out that the State Government made adequate provisions for Education, Health, Agriculture, Water & Sanitation, Commerce & Industry, and Infrastructure as a measure to cushion the effects of Covid-19 Pandemic on the citizenries. She therefore enjoined the participants to always monitor capital component of the budget stressing that it would help them have clear understanding of the programmes and projects of the Government. She disclosed that all information related to the State budget and other fiscal information can be found on the State website (<a href="www.osun.gov.ng">www.osun.gov.ng</a>). She further charged the citizens to always fulfil their civic responsibilities by regular payment of their taxes and other levies to assist Government have enough resources to meet their demands. She, thereafter, implored the citizens to always monitor Government programmes and projects, and report any observed lapses.

3.3 Mrs. Esan who described education as the best legacy, charged participants to always monitor activities of their children and give their education the priority attention it deserves. She thereafter implored farmers who have obtained Agric Loans from the State Government to be patriotic and pay back so that others could benefit from the loans.

## 5.0 Summary of Citizens' Needs

- Rehabilitation of roads across the State
- Drugs and other consumables should be made available in the Government Hospitals across the State
- Strict compliance to tax payment should be enforced to increase Internally Generated Revenue of the State
- Recruitment of qualified and competent teachers
- Renovation and building of Schools in Towns & Villages under Ilie in Olorunda LGA

- There should be a Divisional Police Office Ilie and Police Stations in Towns and Villages under Ilie in order to prevent territorial encroachment from Surulere LGA of Oyo State
- Provision of Boreholes in Towns and Villages under Ilie
- All Social Empowerment Programmes should be made transparent.

## 6.0 Comments/Recommendations/Observations

- 6.1 A number of participants appreciated the State Governor for his frantic efforts to reposition the economy of the State. They also lauded the State Governor for his pragmatic approach towards containing the spread of Covid-19 in the State. However, the following suggestions/contributions among others were made by the participants.
- 6.2 Mr. Sulaiman Abodunrin, a member of Osun Tax Advocacy Group advised the state Government to improve its revenue generation by widening its tax base, blocking revenue leakages in order to meet myriads of demands from the citizenries.
- 6.3 Also, Mr. Michael Ebofin, The Chief Executive Officer, MOWALEK Sustainable Community Development Centres, Osogbo appreciated the State Government for making its budget inclusive and transparent. He implored Government to improve on the empowerment of local contractors/suppliers, and Small and Medium Scale Enterprises so as to enhance job creation and improve revenue generation.
- 6.4 Mrs. Lola Wey, the Executive Director of Eco Centre for Transformation and Empowerment Initiatives appreciated the State Government for creating avenue for people to participate

in public decision making. She advised State Government to develop Tourist Sites and equip them with Arts and Craft training equipment to boost socio-economic capacity of the State. She also noted that there is need for Government to include Vocational Subjects in the Academic Curriculum of Primary and Secondary Schools in the State so as to prepare Students for a life of self-employment and reliance. Mrs. Wey added that there is need for establishment of Waste Recycling Centre in each of the Local Government areas of the State to improve the environmental condition and enhance Internally Generated Revenue (Waste to Wealth Policy)

6.5 Prince Azeez Raifu, the Chairman, Ilie Community Development Authority in Olorunda Local Government Area of Osun State appreciated Government for its efforts towards the betterment of Ilie town and 38 other towns and villages under Ilie in Olorunda south Area Council. He, therefore implored the State Government to complete Ifon-Ilie-Ilosin road which is under construction for easy movement of farm produce such as Cocoa, timber and other cash crop in order to improve Internally Generated Revenue. He also enjoined the State Government to establish Primary and Secondary Schools in some villages ceded to Ilie from Oyo State since education is one of the priorities of the present administration.

6.6 Chief Samuel Layiwola Odekunle, the Lejua of Igbajo Land appreciated the State Government for giving them the opportunity to express their minds. He noted that seeking public inputs early in the budget process is the hallmarks of a good government. He advised the State Government to use

Agricultural development as a tool for creating job opportunity for the teeming youth. He added that Government should use data in driving Agriculture in the State and the Agricultural Farm Settlements should be resuscitated

6.7 The Iyaloja-General, State of Osun, Alhaja (Chief) Awawu Oyebamiji Asindemade (JP) appreciated the State Governor for his wisdom and described him as a man of honour whose God has used for the State. Iyaloja noted that the present economic situation requires a leader who loves his people and possess the skill to lead. She implored Government to note all observations and requests of the citizens for necessary actions. She also charged the citizens to always attend the meeting whenever they are invited because it will give them opportunities to make meaningful contributions to the development of their community and the society at large.

6.8 After responding to questions raised, the Hon. Commissioner for Economic Planning and Budget, appreciated the participants for their laudable contributions.

## 7.0 Closing remarks

7.1 This was delivered by Hon. Remi Kolajo, the Special Adviser to the Governor on Budget. He explained that the main objectives of the meeting were to ensure that citizens have inputs into the year 2021 budget of the State. He therefore appreciated the participants for their time and support for good governance in the State.



## 14.0 Comments/Recommendations/Observations

- 14.2 Mr. Onitiju Kehinde, the Chairman of the vulnerable in Osun East Senatorial District implored the State Government to give education of people with disability a priority in the year 2021 budget. He noted that the challenges being faced by people with disability on school enrolment is enormous since there are few schools of people with disability in the State. He therefore advised the State Government to alleviate their suffering by providing learning and teaching materials for vulnerable students in all schools across the State.
- 14.3 Comrade Adegoke Saidi Ademola, President, the Source Initiative suggested that it is high time the State Government lunched campaign against drug abuse and other social vices in secondary schools across the State of Osun. He also enjoined the State Government to engage youths in Agriculture.
- 14.4 Chief Mrs. Olaleye Janet, who represented women in Agriculture at Oyere Farm Settlement, Ile-Ife implored the State Government to prioritize Agriculture in the 2021 budget. She advised Government to always consider female farmers in its Agricultural Development Programmes such as organizing training for women in Agriculture, provision of improved seed and seedling, provision of chemicals and fertilizers at subsidized rate and provide soft loans to women for farming.
- 14.5 After answering all the questions raised by participants, the Hon. Commissioner for Economic Planning and Budget appreciated them for their commitment and support to government in taking the State to an enviable height.



## 22.0 Comments/Recommendations/Observations

22.1 The Participants from the district expressed their satisfaction with the State Government. Thereafter, some of them made the following contributions.

22.2 Mr. Bamitale Anuoluwapo, a youth leader in Owode Ede, Ede North Local Government appreciated the State Governor for his proyouth policies and programmes. He noted that the peaceful situation of the State is a result of series empowerment programmes being embarked upon for youth development in the State. He thereafter enjoined the State Government to provide soft loan for youth to expand their Businesses because when youth are productively engaged there would be less crime in the society.

22.3 Mr. Akeem Akinsola, the Chairman of people with disability, Ile-Ogbo implored the State Government to always consider people living with disability for employment and empowerment because there are abilities in disability.

22.4 Chief Mrs. Elizabeth Folashade Asafa of National Council of Women Society (NCWS), Iwo branch implored the State Government to always consider women for empowerment and appointment, stressing that women are better managers of human and material resources.

22.5 Mr. Ahmed Shuti, a member of Amin Arabic and Islamic Centre Iwo urged the State Government to use sport as a tool to reduce society menace among youths. He noted that investment in Sports can also boost the Government Internally Generated Revenue in the State. He therefore appealed to the State Government to ensure timely completion of Iwo-Osogbo Road.

22.6 After responding to the questions raised by participants, the Hon. Commissioner for Ministry of Economic Planning and Budget Prof. Olalekan Yinusa appreciated them for their robust contributions.
