



**REPORT OF THE CITIZENS' CONSULTATIVE FORUM FOR THE YEAR
2023 BUDGET, HELD FROM 4TH TO 6TH JULY, 2022 ACROSS THE
THREE (3) SENATORIAL DISTRICTS IN THE STATE OF OSUN**

1.0 PREAMBLE

1.1 In its continual efforts to sustain implementation of the programme objective of the State Fiscal Transparency, Accountability and Sustainability (SFTAS) Programme for Results (PforRs) in the State of Osun, the Ministry of Economic Planning, Budget and Development organized a 3-day Budget Consultative Forum with relevant stakeholders in the three (3) Senatorial Districts of the State. This was done in preparation for the proposed year 2023 budget estimates and to further strengthening the State's fiscal sustainability through increased efficiency in spending, strengthening public revenue mobilization and debt sustainability, rationalization of public expenditure and prevent fiscal crises, and increase the fiscal space for productive spending that will support growth and efficiency in public service delivery. 2.0 OBJECTIVES OF THE CONSULTATIVE FORUM

2.1 The objectives of the consultative forum among others are to:

- ensure continuity and sustainability of the State Fiscal Transparency, Accountability and Sustainability (SFTAS) Programme Objectives in the State of Osun
- fetch from the citizens, the inputs on programmes and projects that would be included in the 2023-2026 Medium Term Sector Strategy (MTSS) before being captured in year 2023 Draft Budget
- ensure the State Budget process is robust, inclusive, participatory and transparent using bottom-up approach in line with the global best practices
- present before the citizens, the successes being recorded with respect to the implementation of years 2022 budget;
- allow citizens to brain-storm and advise the Government on how to improve the State's Internally Generated Revenue (IGR) so as to get resources to fund the capital budget of the State.

2.2 The Participants selected across the 30 Local Governments and One (1) Area Office in the State include but not limited to representatives of:

3.0 WELCOME REMARKS

3.1 The Hon. Commissioner, Ministry of Economic Planning, Budget and Development, Prof. Olalekan Yinusa welcomed the participants to the forum on behalf of the Governor, State of Osun, Mr. Adegboyega Oyetola. While addressing participants across the three (3) Senatorial Districts, the Hon. Commissioner explained that the gathering was not for electioneering campaign but a meeting of intellectuals where critical issues that have to do with growth and development of the State would be discussed.

3.2 The Hon. Commissioner spoke further that Citizens' Consultative Engagement Forum has become a usual practice in the State since the inception of the present administration and it has become a yearly event. He added that the meeting had helped the State Government to have clearer picture of programmes and projects that will have quick and direct impacts on lives of the citizens.

3.3 He informed the participants that Governor Oyetola is highly interested in running inclusive and participatory Government that gives utmost priority to the welfare of the citizens. He thereafter appreciated the Governor for his visionary style of governance and administrative competence demonstrated in piloting the affairs of the State.

3.4 The Honourable Commissioner disclosed further that the Consultative Forum becomes imperative in order to understand critical areas of need of the people so that the limited available resources could be efficiently allocated to meet the yearnings of people of the State.

3.5 The Honourable Commissioner said that on his assumption of office in year 2018, in a bid to ensure that the State policies, programmes and projects are centered on citizens' upliftment, Governor Oyetola immediately embarked on Thank You Tour to the Nine(9) Federal Constituencies of the State. The report of the Thank You Tour was used to harvest information on critical area of needs of the people. This effort was further complemented by the United Kingdom Department For International Development (DFID) in conjunction with the State Government to carry out **Citizens' Needs Assessments** across the Thirty (30) Local Governments and One(1) Area Office in the State. He stressed further that the citizens' requests during the Thank You Tour, Citizens' Needs Assessment and Mr. Governor's Manifestos have been documented and mainstreamed into the State Medium Term Sector Strategy (MTSS) from which the Annual Budgets

are being crafted. This also serve as a tool for the implementation of the State Development Plan (2018-2029).

3.6 He thereafter enjoined the participants to be specific and ask questions that will have direct impacts on lives of the people they represent. He thereafter wished the participants happy and fruitful deliberations.

4.0 PRESENTATION OF YEAR 2022 COMPLETED AND ONGOING CAPITAL PROJECTS

4.1 The presentation of year 2022 ongoing and completed capital projects was made by Mr. Bukola Adesina, the Director of Economic Planning (Osun Ministry of Economic Planning, Budget and Development). He took the participants through the list of capital projects executed by the State Government. After his presentations, the participants across the three (3) Senatorial Districts testified that all the completed projects he presented have been executed by the State Government. The participants appreciated the Governor for his administrative competence and efficiency in management of resources of the State.

5.7 Summary of Citizens' Requests & Contributions

- State Government should improve its Internally Generated Revenue by widening the tax base and blocking revenue leakages
- Provision of Agriculture Credit Facilities to the real farmers in the State.
- Consideration of Community Development Council (CDC) for State Annual Grant so as to complement efforts of the State Government on the Community infrastructural development
- Drugs and other consumables should be made available in the Government Hospitals across the State
- Recruitment of more Health Personnel in the State
- Provision of farm inputs for farmers at an affordable price
- Protection of farmers and farm land from invaders and Land Grabbers
- Creation of new farm settlements and equip the existing ones with basic social amenities
- Enforcement of tax payment in order to increase Internally Generated Revenue of the State
- Establishment of Adult Education Centres for women in all Local Government

- Adequate sensitization of women on the need to properly care for their children

6.0 Comments, Recommendations & Observations

6.1 A good number of participants appreciated the State Governor for the efficient utilization of public fund, increased transparency and accountability in the management of public resources. They also lauded him for always creating avenue for the citizens to have inputs in the State budget process. However, the following comments among others were made by the participants.

6.2 Mr. Abraham Ayodele Famowopo, the Chairman, Community Development Council (CDC) Ajoda Local Council Development Authority (LCDA) appreciated the Governor for the completion of Ada-Igbajo road. He implored the State Government to re-consider Community Development Council (CDC) for Annual Grant so as to complement its efforts on the community development programmes and infrastructural development. He therefore prayed for the peace, progress and development of the State of Osun and Nigeria at large.

6.3 Mr. Sulaiman Abodunrin, a member of Osun Tax Advocacy of Nigeria (Osun State Chapter) advised Government to generate more revenue by widening its tax base, blocking revenue leakages and ensuring automation of all revenue collection systems.

6.3 Azeez Ogunesan Asindemade, a representative of Ilie town in Olorunda South Area Council appreciated the State Governor for his continual efforts towards growth and development of the State. He therefore implored the State Government to complete Ifon-Ilie road so as to improve economic activities of the area.

6.4 Pastor Solomon Adeola, the Chairman, Christian Association of Nigeria (CAN) in Orolu Local Government Area thanked the Governor for his frantic effort to develop the State. He therefore implored the Government to step up efforts to improve security architecture of the State.

21.0 Comments & Recommendations
