### A. <u>PROCEDURES FOR REGISTRATION AND RENEWAL OF PRODUCE</u> LICENCES AND STORES

- (i) The Applicant come forward with application letter to register as a Produce Merchant /Storekeeper in the State.
- (ii) The applicant letter is accompanied with Certificate of registration with Corporate Affairs Commissions, Tax Clearance Certificate for the past 3 years (for state registration)
- (iii). The Warehouse/Store to be used is inspected by Produce Officer.
- (iv) The applicant is advised of the amount to be paid
- (v) The amount is paid into bank and E-receipt issued by bank is brought to the office.
- (vi) Thereafter Certificate of Store Registration and License is issued.

# B. PROCEDURES FOR GRADING OF SCHEDULED PRODUCE (COCOA, PALM KERNEL, CASHEW)

The procedures for grading of scheduled produce are as stated below-

- (i) The Applicant come forward to inform Produce Officer to grade produce.
- (ii) After Inspection of the produce in the store and ascertaining the quantity, the Applicant is advised to make payment into bank.

- (iii) The Applicant then come forward with the E-receipt issued by the bank.
- (iv) The produce is then subjected to necessary Quality Test and evacuated if it meet prescribed quality.

### C. PROCEDURES FOR COLLECTION OF HAULAGE FEES

The procedures for haulage collection are as stated below;

- i. The vehicle carrying the Produce stops at the Control Post.
- ii. The officers at the Control Post will check the vehicle to ascertain the quantity of produce in the vehicle.
- iii. The approved tariff is paid to the officer in charge.
